Re: National Survey Results

In a national survey of 4,332 adults nationwide from February 2nd-5th, 2022, we asked the following question:

Do you agree or disagree with the following statement: "You can't love your country only when you win elections"?

Overall, 73% agree with this statement while just 19% disagree with it. A solid majority (59%) *strongly* agrees with it. This elicits similar responses from Democrats, Independents, and Republicans.

Among specific voter groups, agreement holds:

- 71% of voters age 18-34 agree, 78% of voters age 35-49 agree, 73% of voters age 50-64 agree, and 60% of voters age 65+ agree.
- 69% of Black voters agree, 63% of Hispanic voters agree, and 75% of white voters agree.
- 71% of Urban voters agree, 74% of Suburban voters agree, and 73% of small-town and rural voters agree.

Polling was conducted online from February 2-5, 2022. Using its Dynamic Online Sampling to attain a sample reflective of the electorate, Change Research surveyed 4332 adults nationwide. Post-stratification weights were made on age, gender, ethnicity, education, county population density, and 2020 presidential vote to reflect the distribution of adults.
